| 2 | Are nationals of North Africa (Algeria, Morocco, Tunisia, Egypt and Libya) who:
a) Are registered/work in a higher education institution of these countries that are not included in the partnership (students and staff).
b) Have obtained a university degree or equivalent by an institution of these countries (students only). This includes the possibility of providing mobility opportunities to third-country nationals working in public administration, public and private enterprises and non-profit organizations. |
| 3 | Nationals North Africa (Algeria, Morocco, Tunisia, Egypt and Libya) concerned by the geographical lot who are in particularly vulnerable situations for social and political reasons. The consortium has identified as Target Group 3 individuals with refugee status or asylum beneficiaries (international or according to the national legislation of one of the European recipient countries). |

What is ERASMUS MUNDUS Program?

Erasmus Mundus is a cooperation and mobility program in the field of higher education that aims to enhance the quality of higher education and to promote dialogue and understanding between people and cultures through cooperation between Europe and Third-Countries.

The program is implemented by the Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA). This cooperation is materialized through a comprehensive grant program to implement the mobility of students and staff from North Africa to EU and vice-versa.

ERASMUS MUNDUS AL FIHRI Program

It is a partnership established between 11 North African's Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) in 5 targeted countries (Algeria, Morocco, Tunisia, Egypt and Libya) and 9 European HEIs from 8 different countries (Belgium, France, Germany, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Portugal and Spain) within the framework of the Erasmus Mundus Action 2 Strand 1 Lot 1.

The types of mobility are:

- Undergraduates
- Masters
- Doctorates
- Post docs
- Academic and administrative staff

Coverage of the mobility grant

- **Monthly subsistence allowance** which depends on the type of mobility:

- Undergraduate	1.000 €
- Master	1.000 €
- Doctorate	1.500 €
- Post - doctorate	1.800 €
- Staff	2.500 €

- **Travel, Accident and Health Insurance**

- **One round trip**

Duration of the grant program:

The duration assigned will be linked to the duration of the academic program at Host University

Who can participate?

To be an eligible candidate it is required to:

For North African students and staff:

1. Must be a **NATIONAL** of one of the third-countries
2. Belong to the Target Group 1 or 2 or 3 (see below Target Groups description)
3. Must have **NOT RESIDED NOR HAVE CARRIED OUT THEIR MAIN ACTIVITY** (studies, work, etc) **FOR MORE THAN A TOTAL OF 12 MONTHS OVER THE LAST FIVE YEARS** in any of the eligible European countries at the time of submitting their application to the partnership (this rule does not apply to Target Group 3 candidates)
4. **Proof of language level** required by Host University

For European students and staff:

1. Must be a **NATIONAL** of the European Union
2. Must belong to Target Group 1
3. Must have sufficient knowledge of the language of the courses or of one of the languages currently spoken in the hosting countries
4. **Proof of language level** required by Host University
