Dear colleagues at Université Cadi Ayyad, Faculté de Medecine et de Pharmacie de Marrakech,

Following the note sent on the 22nd of April to all of you about the Tuning Africa Phase II, I am addressing myself to you once the application ONLINE is closed and the selection has taken place.

On behalf of the Managing Committee for the Tuning Africa, I am pleased to congratulate you on the renewal of your University to participate in the project in "Medicine". Participating in this second phase will be an opportunity for your university to develop competence based curricula, build capacity in teaching and learning and quality enhancement, define common and agreed study credits and assessment tools, develop joint agreements between universities and participate in both a continental and international network. This new phase must complete the process of design, taking into consideration the agreements achieved in the pilot project. Besides, it is necessary to focus on the issue of implementation. The challenge for this new phase is how to implement the project at university level.

You may wish to know that we received a large number of high quality applications. The managing committee spent several days reviewing the applications with the advice from the African Union, the Association of African Universities and other African experts. As you will understand, this was not an easy process. Many of you applied at this second Phase to participate in a second area and few have been successful. On this respect, individual mails have been sent to Vice Chancellors.

In order to confirm the participation of the already existing area, we require that your ViceChancellor fills and signs the attached document, and sends it back to us **by the 25th of June 2015, the latest.**

The first project General meeting will take place from the 12th to the 14th of October 2015 in Egypt. We will be inviting the professor who appears in the confirmation document signed by the ViceChancellor as nominee person to participate at the meetings for this area. The representative nominated or confirmed by you as ViceChancellor will receive in due course a formal invitation to participate in this meeting. As on previous encounters, costs of the meeting will be covered by the project (travelling, boarding and visa issue). It is important that your contact person can attend all five general meetings proposed along the three years (one every six months) and we would be very grateful to if you could guarantee this.

Once again, I congratulate you on your engagement with this Tuning Africa Phase II Project and thank you for your continuous support.
